### **Student Welfare**

We take student welfare very seriously. Every student is assigned an academic advisor responsible to help guide them throughout their studies at Philips University. The academic advisor monitors students' progress and guides them throughout their program of study. Our Learning Enhancement Tutors help students improve their study skill and special care is taken

so that students improve their IT and communication skills. Dedicated academic support is available for programming, mathematics and the English language. Our Student Academic Services team can help students deal with accommodation needs, money matters, advice and counselling, and disability needs. We provide a highly confidential service offering individual personal counselling for any student that may need help or advice. Philips University's Students' Union is at the heart of the University and offers an excellent range of social, sporting and support capabilities for all students, including clubs and societies. Finally, Induction Week activities are organised by the University during the first week of students' first year of study. Students are introduced to their program of study and to university facilities such as the library and IT labs.







We provide University-wide IT services. Facilities include an open access PC computer suite which contains workstations where students can use e-mail and web-based services; our computers support a range of software including the Microsoft Office suite and contain state-of-the-art applications, and learning and teaching software facilities. Likewise, Philips University Library plays an active role in the educational life of the University and supports our students' learning. The library contains approximately 35,000 books and periodicals and is continuously updated. Library and IT staff are highly educated, highly trained and committed to helping students progress in their studies.

## Industry collaborations

Philips University has a strong network of industry collaborations and has accumulated expertise in using feedback from industry. Many of our students will benefit from having external mentors and take work placements to build workplace skills and experience.

Industry input is also encouraged in class, by organising guest lectures and activities where industry professionals are able to present areas related to the specific courses. A number of events, workshops and employability activities are organised throughout the year to help students enhance their skills. We hold an annual Industry Advisory Board Meeting to liaise with employers in order to update them of any changes to our programme of study, discuss employability of graduates, and receive feedback upon developing trends in the market.
