5	1981 -1985	Member of a Treatment Team of the Centre for the Social Re-Socialisation of Mentally Ill Persons (1981 - 1985)	<p>This particular activity was a pioneering one for the Cyprus society in general, and particularly for the medical community because the medical model was abandoned and the humanistic model for the treatment of mentally ill persons, which aimed primarily at re-integrating them into the society, was adopted. The effort was characterized as fruitful since it had led to the reduction of mentally ill persons leaving in the mental institution, as well as had given the spark for today's applied reforms. In addition to the above, I was tasked with administrative and training tasks in relation, primarily, to the education/training of the nursing staff.</p>
